**SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY:** The Presbytera Athena Kalpaxis Memorial Educational Fund has announced the availability of scholarships for qualified college students for the upcoming 2018-2019 academic year.

From 1971 until her untimely death in 1984, Presbytera Athena faithfully served as the helpmate to her husband, Father George, as he pastored the St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church in Baltimore. During the period of her long illness which led to her falling asleep in the Lord, Presbytera often expressed the desire to assist deserving young people who because of limited financial resources might not be able to pursue worthy educational endeavors. To honor her wishes--and through the generosity of many benefactors and the efforts of the late Father George and of his family--this scholarship fund was established.

These awards--based primarily on financial need-- are available to, entering or current, undergraduate, graduate, law, and medical students, who are, or will be, attending any accredited college or university, and are Orthodox Christians actively participating in the community life of an Orthodox Church in the State of Maryland.
