- 2. It would be ideal if the clothing has been cleaned and/or laundered before the donation.
- 3. No tank tops with logos will be accepted.
- 4. No shorts or athletic shoes should be donated.
- 5. Blazers, dressy sweaters, coordinated tops and skirts are good.
- 6. Professional shoes, in good condition will be accepted.
- 7. Men's suits and shirts, (on hangers) will also be accepted.

A "Wider Circle" will pick up the the professional clothing on August 23rd, between 10:00 AM and Noon. We will set up a small classroom to accommodate the donations.
