SANCTUARY ICONOGRAPHY As reported at the semi-annual meeting the iconographers will be able to begin working for the completion of the third phase of our project after June 2023. They plan to complete some of the work ahead of time on canvas at their studio in Russia and then take approximately 10 days to complete the work here in the church. The approximate cost to complete the work in the nave including the angels and ornamentation around the stained-glass windows and columns, and the banner under the choir loft is \$32,000 with additional \$20,000 for transportation, scaffolding, housing, and car rental; \$52,000 for the total project cost.

Currently with a balance of \$50,718.50 in the Iconography Fund, we need approximately \$1,281.50 to complete the project.

A WARM WELCOME to Fr. John Parker, Dean of St. Tikhon's Seminary, who is visiting with us today. Fr. John will share with us some information on the health and growth at St. Tikhon's. See his message below:

"Here at St Tikhon's Seminary, we are experiencing growth in spirit and in numbers, thanks to God. I find it truly amazing just how much is happening here, given our limited resources, both human and financial.

While we are truly being blessed with health and strength, we have a ways to go! I describe St Tikhon's as a three-legged horse: a happy, contented, hardworking, but nevertheless, three-legged horse.

We have been growing the faculty; we are adding a much needed administrative position. Our student body is increasing (recall that we have had 16 ordinations since Christmas-among our *current* students!). Our incoming class is 14--recall that we have only one degree, the MDiv, and one central focus: to form clergy. We are doing all that we can to fulfill our mission!

I am writing to ask for your help For our 85th year, we have the goal to add 85 more monthly Sustainers--folks like you who make a monthly, recurring gift to St Tikhon's Seminary. Some sustainers give \$10 or \$25 per month. Others give \$1000 a month or more. Every single Sustainer sustains us!"
